Proxy forms must be properly completed to be deemed valid. Per State law (33-31-724), the HOA is entitled to reject a proxy appointment if the secretary or other officer or agent authorized to tabulate votes, acting in good faith, has reasonable basis for doubt about the validity of the signature on it or about the signatory's authority to sign for the member. This proxy may be withdrawn at any time before the meeting is adjourned.
